



2022 Rod/Line Recommendations

Grain weights are calculated by the amount of line beyond the rod tip while maintaining an anchor. Recommendations are for two-hand spey casting. If lining up for overhead casts, the recommendation is to use 60 grains less than the listed size. Your casting stroke may favor a different-weighted line than we recommend. This is just a starting point.
